NZCCA aims to have robust standards for counselling and supervision. In this regard, we have the following requirements for all those who supervise our members or those applying for membership:

- They are trained counsellors, psychotherapists or psychologists.
- They have been working as qualified full-membered practitioners for at least 5 years.
- They have completed a minimum of 1000 face to face client hours.
- They have undertaken or are undertaking formal training and education in supervision (at least 30 hours minimum).
- They are current members of a New Zealand professional counselling, psychotherapy organisation (NZAC, NZCCA, or NZAP) or members of another professional body acceptable to the membership committee.
- They have regular supervision and undertake regular professional development in the area of supervision.

Please discuss these points with your current or intended supervisor, to ensure that you are being supervised by someone who meets NZCCA's criteria.

If your supervisor does not have the above training and/ or qualifications, but is experienced in supervision, this will be evaluated on a case by case basis by the membership committee on submission of supervisor details. Please fill out the following page if your Supervisor does not fulfil the above criteria.
